#### Section 1: Welcome

We are delighted you are interested in applying for Leadership WA's Signature Leadership Program. Entry to the Program is competitive. You will be contacted within 4 weeks of submitting your application form to arrange an interview. All applications are then assessed by a selection panel and you will be advised of the outcome of your application once the selection process has been completed.

During the selection process, we aim to make the Program cohort a diverse mix of backgrounds, industries, occupations, and experience. This is to ensure the cohort has a wide diversity of thought, which makes for a more rewarding experience for all participants.

- All questions must be completed in full and the declaration must be signed.
- Individuals may nominate themselves but employed applicants must have the full support of their employer to participate. If you are self-employed, you can support your own application.
- You are requested to upload a current headshot (as .jpeg or .gif file) and professional profile / Bio (as Word DOC/DOCX or PDF file) as part of this application. Files must be uploaded prior to submitting the form. (NB: File sizes must not exceed 400kb)
- You can save and continue this form by clicking the link at the bottom of the page. A unique link will be sent to your email. Please note this link will only be active for 90 days.

#### Section 2: Personal details

This section includes standard questions about personal details including contact information, date of birth, cultural background, etc.

#### Section 3: Education

This section includes standard questions about your educational experience, as well as your hobbies and skills.

#### Section 4: Employment and experience

This section includes standard questions about your employment experience, as well as the following:

- How is the organisation you work for/own aligned or involved in the grains industry?
- Please provide a brief description of current responsibilities and role within the business.
- Does your role require you to travel or have periods of peak workloads? (e.g. harvest, seeding)
- Professional Profile (Biography) this can be provided as an attachment if necessary.
- Your reasons for applying for the Growing Leaders Scholarship Program.
- Your personal vision for the WA grain industry.
- Your personal vision for my career/business.
- A few adjectives or phrases that describe you.
