## **Growing Leaders Scholarships awarded to WA farmers**

The CBH Group and Grower Group Alliance (GGA) have announced that two Western Australian farmers are the recipients of prestigious Growing Leaders Scholarships for 2022.

These scholarships are delivered through the Growing Leaders Scholarship Program – an initiative to support the leadership development of existing and emerging WA grain industry and community leaders.

Funding is provided by the CBH Group, applications are coordinated by the GGA and scholar selection and program delivery is by Leadership WA.

Dr Alaina Smith, of Kojaneerup, and Ben Cripps, of Northampton, will develop their skills in Leadership WA's 10-month 2022 Signature Leadership Program, valued at \$15,500 per scholar.

The program brings together a diverse cohort of senior professionals from the corporate, government, small business and not-for-profit sectors across WA.

Dr Smith is a partner in her family's mixed cropping and livestock business on WA's South Coast. She is Vice-Chair of her local grower group, Stirlings to Coast Farmers, and was previously a research officer there.

Dr Smith has a PhD in crop physiology and worked as a barley development officer for the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development prior to joining the family farming business in 2006.

Along with his wife, Mr Cripps operates a grain farm north of Northampton, growing wheat, lupins and canola. He has been an active member of the Northern Agri Group, on which he has served in various roles including Chair.

Prior to managing the farm, Mr Cripps had a diverse career which included working on farms and a period in the Australian Army, in which he was deployed to Afghanistan.

In its fifth year, the Growing Leaders Scholarship Program has supported grain growers and others in the industry to grow and develop their leadership skills. Eight scholars have previously undertaken the program.
