YOUR COMMITMENT TO THE PROGRAM

The Signature Leadership Program requires your commitment and genuine self-investment. At the interview stage, you will be asked your capacity to attend all experiences. Where significant scheduling conflicts apply, Leadership WA will advise you to apply for the following year. You are required to attend a minimum of 80% of experiences, striving for 100% will enable you to wholeheartedly embrace the Program and all it has to offer.

The practice of reflection is at the centre of all Leadership WA Programs. Following each experience day you are required to summarise your key takeaways, challenges and learnings. The integrity of your experience on the Signature Leadership Program relies upon your commitment to participate alongside your cohort, through the sharing of your diverse experiences.

Your active engagement of at least 80% attendance and the completion of post-experience reflections is required to graduate.
