The Grower Group Alliance, in partnership with the CBH Group, is pleased to offer the Growing Leaders Scholarship program, an exciting initiative that supports existing and emerging regional grower leaders to develop and strengthen their leadership in grower groups and the WA grain industry.



The aim of the Growing Leaders Scholarship Program is to:

- Recognise potential influencers and leaders involved with grower groups and the WA grain industry.
- Develop individuals with demonstrated leadership potential in their workplaces or grower group organisations.
- Support and build tomorrow's leaders for strong agricultural and regional communities in WA.

The Growing Leaders Scholarship program offers up two scholarship positions for Leadership WA's highly esteemed Signature Leadership Programs. The program brings together participants from the corporate, government, private and community sectors to develop the skills of leaders and emerging leaders in WA.







GROWING LEADERS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Growing Leaders Scholarships are fully-funded by the CBH Group with the application process coordinated by the Grower Group Alliance (GGA). Growers applying for the Scholarships will be shortlisted by CBH and GGA and then submitted to Leadership WA for interviews and final assessment processes. Leadership WA runs highly sought-after programs and are decidedly selective in how they develop the cohorts for their individual programs. Shortlisting does not guarantee a scholarship position, the final decision and offer remains with Leadership WA.

Program eligibility

- 1. Involved in a grain growing enterprise in WA and based regionally.
- Demonstrated grower group involvement as well as community interest and/or leadership.
- Commitment to the entire program the experiential nature of Leadership WA's programs requires participants to fully participate in all aspects of the program including attending all experiences and providing comment in a reflective manner. Absenteeism resulting in failure to graduate can result in participants reimbursing the CBH Group 50% of the scholarship value, unless there are extenuating circumstances.
- 4. As most program days are undertaken in Perth, participants have to be committed to the attendance, travel and time away from their businesses (which may fall in peak periods like seeding or harvest) and cover travel & accommodation expenses.

- Participants are willing to present to grower groups, CBH forums and industry on their experiences and promote the scholarship program.
- 6. Participants must be under 55 years of age. Female applicants are strongly encouraged to apply.
- 7. Staff from the partnering organisations or industry bodies are ineligible to apply.

The Growing Leaders Scholarship Program covers the value of recipients to participate in the Leadership WA development programs. Participants are required to cover all travel & accommodation costs associated with attending program events and experiences (unless otherwise stated).

Signature

The Signature Leadership Program takes participants on a journey of exploration in self-awareness, self-mastery, and understanding the complex and dynamic context of WA. Participants explore leadership through the lens of current and future issues and engage with a range of inspirational leaders who candidly share insights to their experiences and challenges. Participants also have the opportunity to share stories, difficulties and solutions with peers from a diverse range of sectors, backgrounds and industries.

Participants in the program will:

- Improve their accountability, identity and opportunity in all areas of life
- Expand their personal and professional networks
- Be self-aware with connection to purpose
- Self-reflect and question existing value systems
- Understand complexity and interconnectedness
- Work with ambiguity and take informed risks
- Reach peak personal performance and resilience
- Make wiser, better informed and collaborative decisions

Commitment & Cost

Ten month program with over 21 experiences and includes multi-day field trips to regional WA.

Program value up to \$16,445

Participants are required to cover all travel & accommodation costs associated with attending program events and experiences (unless otherwise stated).

Who should apply?

Leaders, whether experienced as volunteers or in professional roles, who want to expand and enhance their capacity to generate positive impact and influence in their organisations and the broader community. It is for high potential leaders who are wanting to stretch and challenge themselves intellectually and personally.

Two Scholarships available

The Signature Leadership Program is a ten month program for established leaders keen to immerse themselves in an experiential development series. This program is designed around current and future issues that will stretch and challenge leaders intellectually and personally, and enhance their capacity to lead and generate positive impact.
