The Signature Leadership Program is Leadership WA's flagship Program and for 20 years it has brought together high performing, Western Australian leaders, from across all sectors, on a powerful leadership journey. It is a journey that challenges both professionally and personally, and enables each leader to enhance their own authentic leadership.

Signature is a unique 10-month Program held in metropolitan and regional WA. Our unique approach of curating cohorts ensures a diversity of thought, sector, experience and perspectives.



WHY THE SIGNATURE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Signature creates an environment in which you can invest in yourself, while being empowered to make meaningful change for others.

The Program is held under the confidentiality of the Chatham House Rule, which results in a non-competitive and safe space for honest and open discussions.

You will gain an understanding and appreciation of industries and experiences beyond your own sector, from your peers, the organisations you visit and a broad range of expert speakers.

By embarking on the Program, you will benefit from further exploration of leadership concepts and self-reflection, while building links with those joining you on the transformative journey. Often being a senior leader can be an isolating experience. Signature delivers an expanded network, where your cohort members become life-long connections, offering encouragement and support long into the future.

Upon graduation, you can continue your leadership learning and expand your network further, within the influential and like-minded Leadership WA Alumni community.

THE POWER OF EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

Signature is guided by a dedicated Leadership Development Manager, who creates and shapes each Experience Day, around a theme, the speakers and the cohort itself.

> Participants advance together in a uniquely safe and inclusive space, using personal and collective learning designed to challenge thinking and

develop curiosity, while engaging in robust reflection. The practice of reflection is at the heart of Leadership WA Programs, as it enables you to engage more deeply with the content, strengthen your understanding and grow your ability for action.

> During the Program, high level senior leaders from across the WA business, government and community sectors, speak about their own experience as leaders and their lessons learned. In recent years, our cohorts have heard from experts on a range of topics, including leading high performing teams in elite military environments; the first 1000 days in a child's life; emergent thinking on green energy; cyber security; COVID learnings; diversity and inclusion initiatives; and the realities of thriving in regional WA.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Structured around a series of 25 expertly designed and immersive Experience Days, the Signature Leadership Program delivers a transformational blend of:

- In-depth exploration into the meaning of being a courageous leader, stretching far beyond management thinking and with a focus on broader societal issues
- Learning through engagement with diverse WA leaders from a range of industries, who candidly share their journeys and expertise
- Cohort-directed discussions that delve into the responsibilities of leaders, beyond their organisation and in, and for, WA
- Creation of trusted bonds with fellow leaders across diverse sectors
- 3 Executive Coaching sessions with an accredited Coach

The profiling instrument PRINT® is also used as a key element of the Program. This tool enables professionals to take their leadership and motivational skills to the next level. It provides insights into your unconscious motivators and a clearer understanding of self and how you can better engage with others, to cultivate a culture of high performance.

YOUR COMMITMENT

The integrity of your experience on the Signature Leadership Program relies upon your genuine involvement and self-investment.

Participants are required to fully commit to Signature by attending all Program dates. While we build in flexibility to allow for the unexpected, we do require you attend a minimum of 80% of the Experiences to graduate. As such, we recommend deferring your application to a future cohort, if you anticipate you'll have significant scheduling conflicts during the year.

Signature Experience Days are hosted by our partner organisations, in and around the greater Perth metropolitan area. There are also two 3-day regional Field Trips, to the south and north of the State, which all participants are required to attend.

In addition, there is the expectation that for each Experience Day you will spend time preparing for and reflecting on the topics covered and speaker presentations.



SCHOLARSHIPS

We are delighted to offer Scholarships for Signature, supported by the Leadership WA Foundation and our partner organisations.

Scholarships are aimed at applicants who work in small to medium not-for-profit organisations (annual income below \$20 million) or in small businesses.

KEY INFORMATION

Applicants are encouraged to apply regardless of their organisation or personal financial situation. Applicants may be eligible for Scholarships, payment plans or special consideration to receive partial fee waivers.

If you are accepted onto the Program and are seeking external funding, Leadership WA is able to provide documentation to support this effort.

Interviews are held across the application period and early applications are encouraged. Offers are made to all successful applicants when the full Cohort has been interviewed and curated (late 2024). This is to ensure that our unique focus on diversity of experience, sector and perspective within the cohort, is achieved.

While not all applicants will be successful, in many cases you will have the opportunity to be considered for future cohorts.

We ask that you hold all 2025 Experience dates in your calendar in anticipation of a successful outcome.

Transport to and from metropolitan/greater metropolitan experiences or destinations, and personal expenses, are the responsibility of participants. Travel and accommodation in relation to the Field Trips, via bus or aircraft, are included in the Program fees.
